1. AP Schedule

1) Standard : May 1 to 12, 2023

2) Late : May 17 to 19, 2023

- * Late test is limited to KSA students for official reasons such as academic competitions. Applicable only for 'Failed to Examine'

2. Who can take AP

- Born after June 1, 2002

3. Subjects

- Refer to the attached schedule (However, other students can apply on a first-come, first-served basis only for subjects that are taken by this student)
- ※ However, the details of the application may be canceled or changed after reviewing the environment of the classroom related to the government's quarantine guidelines.
- Unable to take multiple exams in the same time zone
- Subject test may be canceled if the number of applicants is below a certain level
- The schedule above may change due to infectious diseases, etc.

4. Registration Period

1) KSA Students: Oct. 14th (Fri) to Oct. 25th (Tue) 17:00

2) Other students: Oct. 26th (Wed) to 8th (Fri) 17:00

5. How to submit registration

1) Submitting an Excel format application

- Fill out the application form and send email (sychoi@ksa.kaist.ac.kr)

2) Online registration of the College Board: After submitting the application form, the KSA AP manager gives the 'registration code'. After that, log in to the College Board site (<https://www.collegeboard.org>) and you must complete online registration

6. Test Fee and how to pay (Flexible)

1) KSA Students

- 220,000 KRW per subject (See the attached criteria (p.3) for 170,000 KRW if the reduction criteria are met)
- It will be collected through school banking (post-announcement)

2) Other students

- 240,000 KRW per subject
- Deposit due: Further notice will be announced in February 2023
- * Test takers and depositors must have the same name

7. Refund

- Further notice will be given in February 2023
- Refund is not possible if the test is not applied on the day of the test
- If changes occur due to the college board or the center's situation, it will be notified individually of the refund-related matters.

8. Mandatory Items and prohibited items

Mandatory	ID card (passport not expired, resident registration card) 2B pencil, eraser, pen (black or blue), Required preparations for each exam subject (permissible calculator, ruler, etc.) ※ Familiarize yourself with the acceptable calculator https://apcentral.collegeboard.org/ap-coordinators/on-exam-day/calculator-policy
Prohibited	Cell phones, laptops, Internet-enabled devices, Bluetooth-enabled devices, recording or recording devices, alarm clocks, cameras, MP3 players and iPods, food items, etc.

9. Guidelines for the day of AP

- 1) Location: Seminar room on the 2nd floor of the Korea Science Academy's Yeji Hall (Seoldonggeungwan) (variable for fluctuation)
- 2) Comply with admission time (If you arrive late after the start of the test, you cannot take the exam)
 - Morning Session (8AM): Check-in until 7:40 a.m.
 - Afternoon Session (12PM): Check-in until 11:40 a.m.
 - Physics C: Electrical and Magnetism (2PM): Check-in until 1:40 p.m.
